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Parents get a LOT of communications, spread between multiple apps and media, and sometimes duplicated between apps and media.

- infinite campus app
- infinite campus email
- schoolCNXT
- school messenger
- classdojo

Some from JCPS, some from schools, some from individual teachers... If you asked me to find, say, info for a specific event - I couldn't tell you where to look, I'd have to cruise through at least 2 apps and my email to find it. But: I'd eventually find it!

I've attached a brief video of what my apps currently look like for reference.

Here's a few specific communication examples and suggestions:

1) In the Infinite Campus app, it can be hard to determine if it's a district or school message.

They all have a title and an author, but rarely indicate the school they are from.

Most of the JCPS messages start with "From JCPS" in the body.


What I'd suggest is putting LPAS in the Subject line for all messages and emails.


E.g. "LPAS: Test to Stay and Book Characters"

And possibly even qualifying what kind of message it is:

"LPAS Update: Test to Stay..." "LPAS Weekly News: etc..."

"LPAS Reminder: ..."








Test to stay

Test to stay started today. If a JCPS student or employee is a close contact of someone with COVID-19, they now have an **option** not to quarantine. To qualify, they have to take a COVID-19 test every night for seven days. If they have a negative result, they can come back to school or work the next day.

Free testing will be offered at middle and high schools and other select locations in the afternoons/evenings. There are now more than 50 locations available across the district. Click here for a list of sites and hours. Click here to watch a video further explaining the program.












2) Also apparently I get some emails from Infinite Campus that I don't also see in the app?

For example here's one from Ms Miller:




Hello families!

Picture Day is November 1st. The link on the form sent home on Wednesday should allow






'Test to Stay' and 'Test to Play' Covid Testing Programs

Test to Stay and Test to Play are two new programs being implemented by JCPS.

The Test to Stay program is an **optional** program for students who have been advised to guarantine and has not tested positive. It involves getting daily testing for seven days and receiving a negative COVID test each day before returning to school. This program begins today, Oct. 17th.

The Test to Play program is a required testing program for students involved in any afterschool activity. Beginning November 1st, students involved in regular, afterschool









4) ClassDojo

I like ClassDojo for keeping up with my kids in class and for communicating with Ms Miller over trivial things. But since it's an app I have concerns about everyone being able to use it and set it up to actually notify you. It shouldn't be used for critical communications for that reason, I think.

It would be nice if it could be universally adopted among teachers, but I get it might not work for everyone.

5) Emails > Apps

SchoolCnXT and Infinite Campus are good apps BUT since they are apps there are considerable hurdles to them and I would consider them "nice to haves" and not requirements for parents. Don't attempt to communicate anything critical in an app. Why?

- not everyone will have access to the app
- not everyone will download the app

- not everyone has notifications for apps turned on
- there are SO MANY apps to pay attention to

But... email most everyone has and can have access to, and there's one place to look. Not perfect, but definitely the most accessible and widely adopted.

So - if you want to push a message to an app, that's fine - but make sure it also goes out via email. That will hit the biggest majority of people.
